


Other Opportunities

WCYO-FM-100.7 "The Coyote"





53% of WCYO listeners are female, 47% are male






WLFX-FM – 106.7 "The Pinnacle"



Named for the peaks that help define the town, the Pinnacle is the most powerful radio station in the local area, with strong coverage not only in Berea, but in all of Madison County and most of the surrounding area. Our programming is targeted at 25-54 year old adults, with a special affinity for moms in their 30s and 40s.

Y-92.5-FM "Richmond's Greatest Hits" WEKY-1340-AM




